Re: Notice of Water Use Fee Rate and Production Report and Fee Payment
Submission Deadlines

Dear Water Well Owner or Operator:

The purpose of this letter is to notify you of the water production fee rates established by the Board of Directors of the Northern Trinity Groundwater Conservation District ("District") for groundwater production from water wells located in Tarrant County as mandated by Rule 6.1 (c) of the District's temporary rules amended December 8, 2011.

As you may already be aware, the District may not assess taxes, but instead is funded by a groundwater production fee in order to generate the revenue necessary to manage local groundwater resources. After consideration of its current expenditures and budget, the District's Board voted to maintain the groundwater use fee rate of 12.5 cents per thousand gallons. This fee applies only to non-exempt groundwater production. What this means is that the fee for groundwater produced will be 12.5 cents per thousand gallons of groundwater produced, unless changed by the Board in the future. The Board voted to maintain the rate through Semi Annual 1 (January-June), 2018. The District is transitioning from an October to September fiscal year to a calendar year. Therefore, the Board will review the groundwater use fee at the end of 2017. The review may result in a possible increase for the Semi Annual 2 (July-December), 2018 reporting period.

Completed production reports and fees for groundwater produced between July 1, 2017 and December 31, 2017, at the applicable rate are due to the District no later than March 1, 2018. Completed production reports and fees for groundwater produced between January 1, 2018 and June 30, 2018, at the applicable fee rate for production within that six-month period, are due to the District no later than September 1, 2018.
