Re: Notice of Water Use Fee Rate and Deadlines for Production Report and Fee Submission

Dear Water Well Owner or Operator:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the water production fee rates adopted by the Board of Directors ("Board") of the Northern Trinity Groundwater Conservation District ("District") for groundwater production from wells located within Tarrant County. These rates are established in accordance with Rule 6.1(c) of the District's Rules, originally adopted on December 17, 2018, and most recently amended on September 21, 2023.

As you may be aware, the District does not levy taxes but is funded through groundwater production fees, which provide the revenue necessary to support District operations. After reviewing its expenditures and budget, the District's Board of Directors voted to increase the groundwater use fee rate to **\$0.16 (16 cents) per thousand gallons, effective January 1, 2026**. This fee applies only to non-exempt groundwater production occurring on or after that date. Unless modified by the Board in the future, the rate will remain \$0.16 per thousand gallons of groundwater produced.

Completed Water Production Reports (WPRs), including monthly meter reading logs and applicable fees, are due to the District as follows:

- **Production occurring July 1, 2025 – December 31, 2025 (2025 Semi-Annual 2):** Reports, meter logs, and fees, calculated at the rate of \$0.155 per thousand gallons, must be submitted no later than **January 31, 2026**.
- **Production occurring January 1, 2026 – June 30, 2026 (2026 Semi-Annual 1):** Reports, meter logs, and fees, calculated at the new rate of \$0.16 per thousand gallons, must be submitted no later than **July 31, 2026**.
