

Northern Trinity Groundwater Conservation District Notice of Hearing On Proposed Desired Future Conditions

June 2, 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all interested parties within Tarrant County, Texas:

That the Board of Directors of the Northern Trinity Groundwater Conservation District (“Northern Trinity GCD”) will hold a public hearing and accept public comment on the proposed desired future conditions (“DFCs”) for the aquifers underlying Tarrant County, Texas, in accordance with Section 36.108(d-2) of the Texas Water Code. The purpose of the hearing is to provide interested members of the public the opportunity to appear and provide comments to the Northern Trinity GCD related to the proposed DFCs.

The Northern Trinity GCD is one of eleven groundwater conservation districts located wholly or partially within Groundwater Management Area 8 (“GMA 8”); the other districts in GMA 8 include Central Texas Groundwater Conservation District, Clearwater Groundwater Conservation District, Middle Trinity Groundwater Conservation District, North Texas Groundwater Conservation District, Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District, Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District, Red River Groundwater Conservation District, Saratoga Underground Water Conservation District, Southern Trinity Groundwater Conservation District, and Upper Trinity Groundwater Conservation District. At the last GMA 8 joint planning meeting, held on March 31, 2026, the district representatives voted unanimously to approve the proposed DFCs, which have been distributed to the individual districts for a 90-day comment period and public hearing. The proposed DFCs relevant to Northern Trinity GCD are included below:

Any person who desires to appear at the hearing and present comment or other information on the proposed DFCs may do so in person, by legal representation, or both. Limits may be placed on the amount of time that each person is allowed to present verbal comments, but written comments may also be submitted. Written comments will continue to be accepted by email, mail, or in person through July 31, 2026. The hearing in this notice may be recessed from day to day or continued where appropriate.
